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Palmer Electric to wire Osceola elementary school

WINTER PARK, Fla., October 1, 2008 — The commercial division of Palmer Electric Co. announced today it has secured a \$2 million contract with W.G. Mills Inc., a general contractor, for the electrical work for a new building on the campus of Narcoossee Community School in St. Cloud, Fla.
