Palmer Electric Co. wins contract to upgrade middle school electrical and cabling

WINTER PARK, Fla., June 29, 2009 — The special projects division of Palmer Electric Company has secured a \$600,000 contract for upgrades to Hunters Creek Middle School located in south Orange County, Fla. Under its contract with general contractor Williams Company, Palmer is providing the electrical work for a new heating ventilating and air conditioning system, and is installing cabling to network the existing nine-building campus. According to Palmer Electric's Manager of Special Projects Ron Howard, the fast track project is scheduled for completion in 40 days.

Orange County Public Schools is the owner. The general contractor is the Williams Company of Orlando, Fla. SGM Engineering Inc. of Orlando Fla., is providing electrical engineering.

Built in 1994, Hunters Creek Middle School is located on 25-acres in south Orange County, Fla. The nine-building campus totals 158,711-square-foot of space for administration, cafeteria/auditorium, information/media center and classrooms.
